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## Youth Artist/Craftsperson Requirements

- The Bellefonte Arts & Crafts Fair takes place on Allegheny & High Streets in downtown Bellefonte. The fair is held rain or shine. Artists sales are Friday 10:00-8:00, Saturday 10:00-5:00. Youth artists will be set up around the diamond area. **Youth sales are Friday and/or Saturday from 10:00-3:00** but may stay longer if they choose.
- The Bellefonte Arts & Crafts Fair is a JURIED fair.
  - All items must be handmade and original products of the applicant.
  - You cannot have any manufactured, buy & sell items, kits, or pre-cut components.
  - Only items produced by the artist and approved by the Jury Committee may be sold at the Fair.
- Youth artists must be 8-17 years of age at the time of the Fair.
- Applicant may choose to be present Friday or Saturday or both days.
- Representatives, including family members may not attend in place of the artist. An adult must be present during the fair hours.
- Previous acceptance to the Bellefonte Arts & Crafts Fair is not a guarantee of acceptance for the 2020 Fair.
- Set up time: Booths must be set up and ready to go by 10:00 a.m. and be present until 3:00 p.m. We would advise that you bring a cart or wagon to transport your items to and from the Fair.
- Parking is wherever you can find a space downtown. Note: There is free parking at the high school with a free shuttle to the Fair.
- Spaces will be assigned and are limited to a 10' x 10' area. Exhibitors must bring their own canopy, tables, and/or chairs. Be prepared for all weather. Canopy weights and sides are strongly advised.
- NO electricity or water will be provided.
- Musical entertainment will be provided throughout the day therefore we ask that no music be played in your booth area unless using headphones.
- Artists may not sell raffles or games with prizes, or use licensed, trademarked or copyrighted characters.

## Application & Fees

- Applications are due no later than **June 15, 2020**. Only completed applications will be considered.
- **One application per youth artist**. If artists are sharing a booth each youth must have a completed application.
- Only need to return page 1 of application. You should keep page 2 for your reference.
- All applicants must send a picture of the artist's work in a jpeg file sent via email for jurying to [fair@bellefontefair.org](mailto:fair@bellefontefair.org). Photos may also be used for promotional purposes. Faded or blurry images will not be accepted. Include your last name as part of the file name so they can be matched to your application.
- Checks for Registration Fee made out to **Bellefonte Arts and Crafts Fair** (no credit cards)
  - **Entry fee is \$5.00 per day per artist**
  - Non-refundable fee for cancellations or no shows
- Application fee reserves a 10' x 10' exhibition space (does not include canopy, tables and/or chairs).
- An acceptance/rejection letter will be emailed after review of application & photos.
- **Bellefonte Arts & Crafts Fair is not responsible for lost or misdirected email.**
